Fabric



Cotton



Blend

Cotton is often the preferred choice, as it is durable and breathable. However, a blend of materials can provide moisture-wicking properties, which help keep the skin dry.

Neckline

Depending on employee build and work requirements, they may want a V-neck which is ideal for petite or athletic individuals. A scoop neck is a relaxed option that elongates the neckline, while a split neck is a women's scrub with a round neckline that splits in the center.

Princess Seams

A loose waist can provide a more comfortable fit, and it's not limited to men's scrubs. On the other hand, a wrap waist can create a slimmer impression but typically does not have pockets. Another option is princess seams that are sewn into women's scrubs to follow the shape of the body.

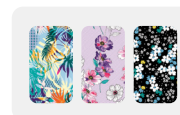
Print/Color

Lighter Colors



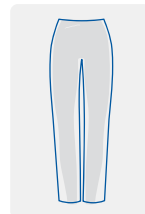
Prints

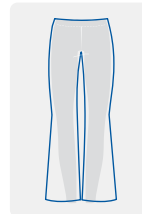
